How to play Golf?

While beginner golfers compete in a 9-hole area, more professional golfers prefer the 18-hole golf course. If played on an 18-hole golf course, the person who completes 18 holes with the fewest strokes wins the game. Each golf course is designed differently, provided that the principles of the game are adhered to.

Rules of Golf

If the field is damaged during the stroke, necessary corrections are made and the ball traces are deleted. Sticks must be counted and can be played with a maximum of 14 sticks. Situations and actions that will negatively affect the opponent should be avoided, and attention should be paid to being a sportsman. The golfer who has started to prepare for the stroke should not move or speak until he has made the stroke.

Who can play Golf?

Played on a flat terrain without spending much energy, golf is played by people of all ages. Golf, which is a sport that children as well as young people show special interest, is an effective game to relieve stress. It is a sport that anyone can do for life.



What are the benefits of playing golf?

Golf, which is a sport played with the mind, requires high concentration. Golf, which is a very good sport for the body, reinforces flexibility. Carrying golf clubs and even walking on the golf course is considered exercise. Compared to other sports, the cost of playing golf is extremely low.
