Clock Tower

I started to know Prilep by visiting the city center. I saw a few very historical artifacts. One of them was the Clock Tower. This clock tower, which is one of the symbols of the city, was built during the Ottoman period.



King Marko Statue

I saw the statue of King Marko in the middle of the town square. This statue added a special beauty to the square. He crowned Marko as "young king" in 1370. This title basically indicated that in the event of the king's death, Marko should be his successor. King Marko was a regional lord who ruled a relatively small area in western Macedonia. Marko was a vassal of the Ottoman Empire during his reign. He died in 1395 while fighting in the Ottoman ranks in the Battle of Rovine against the Wallachians of the Ottoman Empire.



Burek

I tried Burek, which is very popular in Macedonia and even in the Balkan countries. Since similar pastries are made in Turkey, it was similar to them and tasted good. You have two options, with minced meat and cheese. I tried both, but in my opinion the one with ground beef was better. I recommend you to try it when you come here.

Art Cafe

Art Cafe, one of the most popular cafes in Prilep, is a place you can easily choose. You can drink cocktails at very reasonable prices for 1.5-2 Euros. I tried the beer produced in Prilep. The name of the brand was Zlaten Dab.
